Preface (1830, 1930, 2003)

The time prescribed by our nation's foreign affairs, a certain economic condition of our city's street sellers, and an ongoing exchange with a scenery painter from one of the fine European capitals, were the reasons why I recently took pause at an oversized volume of Hollywood Musicals on Avenue of the Americas. On this particularly gray day, marked by the American invasion in Persia—as I would later detail in my memoirs—I was struck by how the American subjects have, throughout the ages, regarding attitudes and manners, delighted their understanding of war through entertainment. As these elements aligned themselves in my orbit, I began my libretto: *WAR, THE MUSICAL*.

For this diversion I have written: an overture, 9 songs as scenes in verse, and, finally, the libretto itself. Commencing with only the titles of nine 1930's Hollywood Musicals, I was then led to borrow from a variety of personal confessions and amusements which substitute for the more traditional canzonettas, arias, and, indeed, musical composition itself. For, I must confess, to this date no composer has stepped forward to orchestrate my libretto, and I have been unable to persuade the Metropolitan Opera to mount it.

In spite of all the zeal and care on my part to create an original musical comedy, the libretto, instead, is an unoriginal tragic love story, faithfully painting the diverse passions that are aroused in that parallel universe known as media. The libretto loosely recounts the tale of 2 young lovers, Robert and Rachel, who meet as servers in an American Family restaurant (perhaps *Applebee's*), open a dotcom enterprise, make money, travel to foreign lands, suffer the dotcom demise, join the armed forces, and perish in the war. It is my sincere hope that this public of such refined taste and acute perception will excuse this purloined spectacle of a personal nature that is, in fact, not my *own* person.

6. I'd Love to Take Orders from You

0001 I'm in love with my sweater but I need to know how long International shipping orders take. When online grocery pioneer Webvan Inc. checked out last week, it closed the doors on one of the Web's most ambitious and expensive IT distribution infrastructures, which likely will be broken up and sold off in pieces.

0002 The seeing is believing thing doesn't really work here because there are plenty of us working out there silently.

0003 Still licking their wounds from the recent demise of my8848.net, the former top icon of China's e-commerce industry--online retailers--are bracing themselves for another body blow: an erosion of consumer confidence.

0004 The closure will strengthen public skepticism on the viability of the business, and it will be the biggest setback for the dot coms, already suffering financial deficits and the capital squeeze. The internalization and preferencing of order flows take orders away from traders who price aggressively.

0005 Robert and Rachael take the

orders, monitor aircraft movement, plot and give information, and account for the retardant each air tanker dispenses.

0006 "I was lucky though," she said. "Some of my friends have been cheated out of money by some websites who promised to deliver goods but they never showed up. Some websites could not even be traced via the Internet."

0007 Hi, I'd like to extend a warm welcome to you and the folks in your department.

0008 The books are always delivered on time and I can even be updated about the latest book on sale, getting free coupons and handsome discounts. The customer can also call an 800 number that is answered by personnel in Canada who are authorized to take orders.

0009 Counter and rental clerks also take orders, calculate fees, receive payments, and accept returns. GENTLE READER: I can only say that if you're getting sick and tired of my naysaying of the printing industry, think about how I feel.

0010 It's not like the company itself does not have its own manufacturing units of some products. The message is simple folks -- I expect each of you to be ready, willing, and able to take orders when the time comes.

0011 This does not bode well for a bleeding industry still finding its feet after a global Internet slump since late last year. Venture capitalists are still tightening their money belts, while the B2C (business to consumers) model--online commerce--has, to date, not delivered a dime of business profit.

0012 These kits are very close to their release dates... so close, in fact, that we've decided to start taking orders for them. Applause and whoops of joy swept through a room full of Boeing workers as the company announced it will start taking orders for the new 7E7.

0013 In-plant managers share how they've convinced customers to leave hard copy behind. It's a shame some customers have to make it so difficult for a manager who's trying to make their lives easier.

0014 A new human resources manager appeared — although it was not clear if there would be any human resources to manage.
